



Monochrome Quick Start Guide

- Install Monochrome in your Applications folder and launch the application. The Monochrome Project Document window will display.
- To add images to the project, click the “Import Images” icon on the toolbar or drag one or more items from the Finder.
- To remove images, select the desired items then press the delete key.
- When an image is selected in the tray, it displays in the preview area. The display mode selector (below the image) lets you see the original image, the converted preview or an overlay/stack of both images.
- The settings pane, to the right of the Main Window, let you select how images are converted and what effects can be applied to the final product. Simple adjustments, like contrast, are also available on this panel.
- Adjust the image processing to your liking.
- To save the converted image, click the “Export” icon on the toolbar. To view the images as a slideshow, click the “Slide Show” icon. To print the images, click the “Print” icon.
- While images are being exported, their progress may be monitored by clicking the “Activity” icon
- To share your images, via e-mail or various popular internet services (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, etc.), click the “Share” icon on the toolbar.
